EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. MSJ-030  
SERIES 2022-2023

TO DELEGATE MR. ISRAEL O. ALICEA LUCIANO, CITY ADMINISTRATOR OF THE AUTONOMOUS MUNICIPALITY OF SAN JUAN, AS THE "CERTIFYING OFFICER", IN ACCORDANCE WITH 24 C.F.R., PART 58 AND OTHER AUTHORITIES.

**WHEREAS:** The Autonomous Municipality of San Juan, Puerto Rico, is an entitlement grantee of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grant Program, HOME Investment Partnership Program and HOPWA Funds.

**WHEREAS:** These funds are subject to environmental review, decision-making, and action responsibilities under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), and 24 C.F.R. Part 58, "Environmental Review Procedures for entities Assuming HUD Environmental Responsibilities".

**WHEREAS:** We must issue an Executive Order to delegate a Certifying Officer to represent the Autonomous Municipality of San Juan, in accordance with the above mentioned federal authorities, and others related.

**THEREFORE:** I, Miguel A. Romero Lugo, as Mayor of the Autonomous Municipality of San Juan, and by virtue of the authority and powers conferred on me by Article 1.018 (y) of Law 107-2020, as amended, known as the "Municipal Code of Puerto Rico", **HEREBY DECLARE THE FOLLOWING:**

**FIRST:** Delegate on Mr. Israel O. Alicea Luciano, City Administrator of the Autonomous Municipality of San Juan, the authority to carry out the responsibilities of Certifying Officer as provided in 24 C.F.R. Part 58, its related federal authorities listed in Sections 58.5 and 58.6, as well as Section 102 of NEPA and its related provisions in 40 CFR parts 1500 through 1508.

**SECOND:**

The effective date of this delegation is immediate and shall run until revoked by me or by the end of my term in office. The authority delegated is not subject to sub-delegation.

**IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF**, I hereby issue this Executive Order under my signature in the City of San Juan, Puerto Rico, United States of America, on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of October of 2022.
